NOTE: Attach a copy of the tax parcel number or other suitable description of the property on which hunting is to occur. If you are not the owner of the property, a letter giving you permission to hunt on this property must be submitted by any landowner for all property and attached to this application.

In accordance with Chapter 130, Section 2 of the City Code, a person may apply to the Chief of Police for a hunting permit to use shotguns or bow and arrows on his property or with written permission of the property owner on tracts of contiguous land 15 acres in size or larger. The permit shall remain in effect for a period of not more than one year from date of application. The permit shall authorize hunting, as specified by state law, by the applicant approved by the Chief of Police, and it shall be revocable by the Chief of Police or on-duty police officer upon violation of its conditions or upon complaint that the permit holder is not exercising his privilege in a careful and prudent manner and with due regard to life and property.
